

PARKING

ROSIERES

The parking at Rosières (capacity estimated at about 130 cars - *if the adjacent meadow is accessible, which may not be the case under bad weather conditions*) could become overfull during the day. If you follow the instructions given by the Rixensart club representatives (RUR) as last year, you should not experience any problems.

We also insist that **parking** on **the road**, **alongside the installations**, "**outside markings on the ground**" is **strictly forbidden**, especially since the configuration of the site (narrow roads) could lead to serious safety and traffic problems, especially if large emergency vehicles (ambulances, fire trucks) need to use them.

You will recall that in 2015, that thanks to the intervention of the President of RUR with the local police dozens of unruly colleagues were not fined.

Please note that there will be no preferential treatment this year and that all offenders will face a large fine.

CIE Overijse

As you know, the location of the Center in a residential area increases the difficulty of parking without disturbing the residents and the neighborhood.

The Committee insists that all participants respect these residents and their property. **Do not do what you can not stand for.**

Given the limited number of parking places at CIE Overijse and in the immediate adjacent street (50 spaces), we inform you that these areas will only be accessible to cars with at least 3 people on **board** (of course, in the limit of its capacity). Others will have to park in the neighboring streets.

A check will be made at the first intersection of the streets by persons mandated by the Center's officials.

For the above-mentioned reasons, the Committee wishes to encourage car-pooling:

• from Brussels (leave car at park DELTA or KRAAINEM, ...= 15/20 minutes from Rosières/Overijse).
